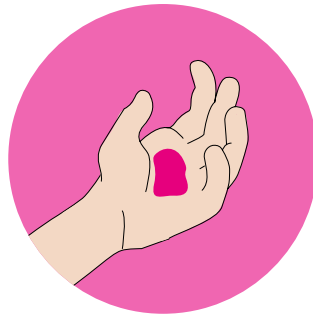

For hygienic hand washing, wet hands and forearms.

Dispense approx. 5ml into palm of hand.

Rub hands palm to palm. Rub palms over the backs of each hand and rub with fingers interlaced. Rub hands palm to palm fingers interlaced. Backs of fingers to opposing palms with fingers interlocked.



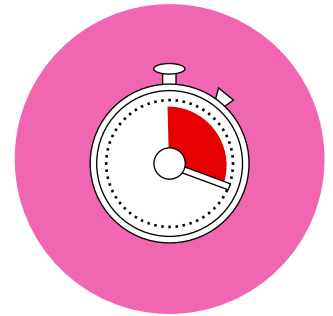

Rub the thumbs in the opposite palm. Rotational rubbing backwards and forwards of tips of fingers and thumb of right hand in left palm and vice versa.



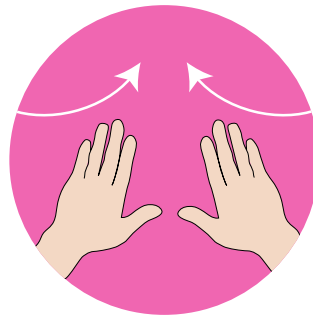

Ensure all surfaces of the hands are covered and keep washing hands for 60 seconds.

Rinse hands for 15 seconds then dry hands.



and rinse under running tap water at 20°C for 15 seconds.

– Apply 5ml on hands and scrub for 90 seconds, wash and rinse under running tap water at 20°C for 15 seconds.

– Apply 5ml on hands and scrub for 2 minutes, clean fingernails with brush.

– Final rinse for 10 seconds then dry hands

– Apply 5ml on wet hands and rub for 60 seconds.

– Final rinse for 15 seconds then dry hands.

a, 2-hydroxy-1,2,3-propane tricarboxylic acid, fragrance, 2-aminoethanol

Chlorhexidine digluconate 1.0–5.0% w/w
